2021-22 Transportation Guidelines

Although we try our best to communicate each BCTC transportation scenario, situations do occur which may require us to modify our guidelines. As such, each parent and BCTC student will receive specific instructions the day before and/or the day of each situation noted below.

Governor Mifflin High School students attending BCTC will attend the morning session only. All BCTC busses will depart the high school at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 10:45 a.m. BCTC students will have their **lunch period at GMHS**.

Due to the fluctuation between the school calendars, the following transportation parameters will be in place for this school year:

- **Normal school day – both BCTC and GMHS in-session:**
(NOTE: Please refer to your child’s Skyward account for specific GMHS transportation information – bus stop and bus number.)
 - All BCTC students will depart GMHS at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 10:45 a.m.
- **BCTC is in-session, but GMHS has NO school (non-weather related):**
 - On **Friday, August 27 only**, BCTC students must find their own transportation to and from GMHS; the district will **NOT** provide transportation for students on this day. BCTC will provide transportation to and from the BCTC campuses only. The busses will depart GMHS at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 10:45 a.m. Your child will not be required to attend BCTC on this day if you are not able to provide transportation to and from GMHS.
 - On the remaining days that BCTC is in-session, but GMHS has no school (non-weather related), all BCTC students will depart GMHS at approximately 7:30 a.m. and return at approximately 10:45 a.m. On these specific days, transportation to and from the high school will be provided by district busses; BCTC will provide transportation to and from the BCTC campuses. In December, alternative “bus information” will be mailed home. This information will indicate modifications to bus stops and bus numbers for these specific days.
- **BCTC in-session, and GMHS is operating on a two-hour delay bell schedule:**
(NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

 - In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin at **10:35 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
 - Or, report directly to the high school no later than **10:30 a.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- **GMHS in-session, and BCTC has NO school or operating on either a two or three-hour delay bell schedule:**
(NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

 - In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin at **10:50 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
 - Or, report directly to the high school no later than **10:45 a.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
- **Both GMHS and BCTC have a two-hour delay:**
(NOTE: Students will not report to BCTC on this type of day.)

Students have two options:

 - In the morning, they can arrive at the high school on their regular bus and report directly to study hall until their classes begin at **10:35 a.m.** For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
 - Or, report directly to the high school no later than **10:30 a.m.** Students must find their own transportation; the district will **NOT** provide bussing for students wishing to use this option. For attendance purposes, all BCTC students must sign in at the Attendance Office upon their arrival.
